

The Eleanor Waner Dedmon Scholarship
for Students Seeking the Spanish Endorsement or Minor
at East Central University

Terms of Scholarship:

The Eleanor Waner Dedmon Scholarship will provide one first-year student, seeking the Spanish endorsement or minor, funding for tuition, fees, and books. It also provides for room and board (semi-private room only) if the student lives in university housing. Students who continue seeking the Spanish endorsement or minor and maintain at least an overall 3.25 GPA and who complete at least 24 credit hours per year will be re-awarded the scholarship for a maximum of eight consecutive, regular semesters. Summer school is not included.

Eligibility:

Those entering their first semester of full time college enrollment who have completed no more than twelve semester hours (not counting advanced standing).

Those students who are committed to either a teaching endorsement or a minor in Spanish. The teaching endorsement requires 24 hours of Spanish beyond Spanish I. The minor requires 18 hours of Spanish beyond Spanish I. Those seeking the teaching endorsement will have preference over those seeking a minor.

Those having an ACT score of 25 or higher.

Preference will be given to students ineligible for Federal Financial Aid who can show evidence of economic need.

Application and Selection Process:

Complete the Eleanor Waner Dedmon Scholarship Application Form. Attach official copies of high school transcript (or equivalency of high school diploma), two letters of recommendation and your ACT scores, (one letter of recommendation should be from a high school junior or senior Spanish teacher). An essay as specified on the application form should also be included. An interview with the ECU Eleanor Waner Dedmon Scholarship Committee is a part of the selection process.

Continuation Terms and Details:

The Eleanor Waner Dedmon Scholarship will be re-awarded for a maximum of four years (eight consecutive, regular college semesters) if students maintain at least an overall 3.25 GPA, complete at least 24 credit hours per academic year in courses leading to an efficient completion of the Spanish endorsement or minor, and remain in good standing with the university.

Any additional financial aid (federal or state aid, fee waivers, scholarships, grants, etc.) will reduce the Eleanor Waner Dedmon Scholarship by the same amount.

Room and board funds are contingent on living in university housing.

No books provided by scholarship monies may be sold for cash. Students may keep all texts in their major and in their Spanish endorsement. . Other texts must be returned to the ECU Foundation.
