MATH AND SCIENCE TEACHER'S SCHOLARSHIP**

**The DON and JANE KELLOGG MATH AND SCIENCE TEACHER SCHOLARSHIP was established to assist students pursuing a secondary mathematics or science certification degree at East Central University.**

*The freshman year award will be a total of \$1000 divided between the first and second semesters of attendance. To be considered, the following documents must be completed and presented to the Scholarship Selection and Retention Committee:*

1. *An application for admission to East Central University including transcript and ACT scores,*
2. *An ECU MATH AND SCIENCE TEACHER SCHOLARSHIP Application Form,*
3. *Two letters of recommendation from math and/or science teachers that know the applicant, and*
4. *A letter from the student addressing their interest and attributes in teaching math/science.*

*Selection of the recipient for this scholarship will be made by the MATH AND SCIENCE TEACHERS SCHOLARSHIP Selection and Retention Committee.*

*Preference will be given to applicants based on the following criteria:*

1. *A graduate from an accredited Oklahoma high school,*
2. *A high school GPA above a 3.0,*
3. *An ACT composite score of 20 or higher, or*
4. *An ACT math and science sub scores of 18 or higher.*

**FIRST RETENTION**

*The two semesters immediately following the student "receiving unconditional admission to teacher education" the recipient will receive \$1000 each semester. The student must maintain a declared major in the teacher certification major in math or science as well as be enrolled in courses leading to the appropriate secondary teaching certification degree.*

**SECOND RETENTION**

*A \$2000, one time, award will be given for the semester of student teaching.*

**SELECTION AND RETENTION COMMITTEE**

*The committee will be composed of the following four representatives:*

1. *Dean of the College of Health and Science (committee chair),*
2. *A professor from one of the secondary science certification programs,*
3. *A professor from one of the secondary math education programs, and*
4. *Dean of the College of Education and Psychology.*

*Students not meeting the retention criteria will be replaced by the committee. The committee will decide on exceptions to the policy as well as any appropriate policy changes*
