

SCHOLARSHIPS AT EAST CENTRAL UNIVERSITY FOR HISTORY MAJORS

Guidelines for the Louise Hornbeak Scholarship in History

1. Completed applications should be mailed to Hornbeak Scholarship Committee, c/o East Central University Foundation, ECU Box Y-8, Ada, OK 74280. **Applications are due by March 1.**
2. Recipients of the scholarship will be known as "Hornbeak Scholars".
3. Eligible applicants will meet the following criteria:
 - a. Must have declared history as their major and must be enrolled in an adequate number of hours in history courses each semester and be advancing satisfactorily toward that end.
 - b. Must complete 24 or more hours during the Fall and Spring semesters.
 - c. Incoming freshmen must have scored a 26 or above on the ACT.
 - d. Students already attending ECU, transfer students, and junior college graduates must have a cumulative GPA of 3.25 or above at the end of the academic year.
 - e. Students must be in good standing with the university and maintain their posture as good citizens as well as good students.
4. The amount of the scholarship will vary with the maximum scholarship covering tuition, books, fees, room and board. Books must be purchased from either Folletts Books Store or Thompson Book Store.
5. All Hornbeak Scholars receiving a full scholarship will be required to live in the university housing. Recipients in this category choosing to live off campus remain eligible for the tuition, fees, and books portion of the scholarship.
6. Prospective recipients must come to the campus for an in-depth interview with designated history faculty and a member of the East Central University Foundation Scholarship Committee. The final approval will be given by the Scholarship Committee of the East Central University Foundation.
7. All Hornbeak Scholars are expected to arrange a mid-term conference with their assigned adviser each semester. It will be the student's responsibility to contact their advisor to schedule the conference.
8. Failure to maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.25 at the end of the end of the academic year (Fall and Spring semesters) will result in the loss of the scholarship.
9. Tuition for exchange students receiving the Hornbeak Scholarship will be paid as long as they are considered East Central students and the tuition is the same as other regularly enrolled students.

The scholarship will end when the recipient has accumulated 124 hours, and the scholarship includes payment of room and board for no more than eight academic terms. Any additional financial aid or fee waivers will be subtracted from the amount of the scholarship. All textbooks (other than history textbooks) must be returned to the Foundation Office at the end of each term.
