## CHESAPEAKE CARTOGRAPHY SCHOLARSHIPS GUIDELINES

**Chesapeake Scholars** are awarded \$1,000 to \$1,500 for the academic year. An individual may be a scholarship recipient up to four times during his or her academic career.

**Eligibility:** Students who are or will be **Majoring in Cartography at East Central University** are eligible to apply for a Chesapeake Cartography Scholarship, provided they have at least a sophomore standing for the upcoming academic year.

**Qualifications:** Up to eight applicants for the next Fall Semester who *best* meet or exceed the following criteria will be awarded a Chesapeake Cartography Scholarship.

All students

Enroll in at least 12 credit hours for the upcoming semester.

Enroll in courses that make progress toward a degree in Cartography.

Possess a minimum GPA of 3.25 (on a 4.00 scale)

A letter of application describing why the student feels she/he is deserving of being a Chesapeake Scholar  
College transcript

Additional consideration will be given to those majors whose concentration is in Geotechniques.

Additional consideration will be given to those majors who are in the ECU Honors Program.

Additionally, students not currently enrolled at East Central University shall provide the following:

ACT or SAT scores

Letter of recommendation from an educator

**Disbursement:** Each student will receive one-half of the scholarship monies at the beginning of the fall semester and the remainder at the start of the spring semester. Should a student not retain the criteria listed above during the time of the scholarship, he/she will be subject to review by the cartography faculty and may have the remainder of the scholarship revoked.

**Application:** Print the form found online at [ecok.edu/cartogeo](http://ecok.edu/cartogeo), select the *Scholarships* link, then *Chesapeake Application*. The completed form with supporting materials must be received on or before at dates shown online. Submit your application to:
