VII. Special Requirements

For graduation, a minimum grade point average of 2.25 is required in the 42 hours of courses with ACCT prefixes.

Students majoring in Accounting must take at least 40 percent (50 credit hours) of their course work in non-business courses. However, BUCOM 3133, ECON 2003, ECON 2013, MIS 1903 will be considered non-business courses for this requirement.

The OSRHE computer proficiency graduation requirement will be met through completion of MIS 1903 (including equated or substituted courses), OR successful completion of an associate of arts or associate of science degree at an Oklahoma two-year college in which the computer skills requirement was met. Satisfaction of this requirement may not reduce or remove any program requirements.

Students beginning at East Central University in the fall 2007 semester or later who have earned less than sixty-four semester hours are required to take two classes with designated service-learning component. Student transferring to ECU for the first time in the fall 2007 semester or later with sixty-four or more semester hours will be required to take one class with a service-learning component.
