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### **General Education Requirements:**

- o GE requirement is 40 hours
- Must take at least one (1) course that meets each of the five (5) learning outcomes. {Communication; Critical Thinking; Information Literacy; Intercultural Knowledge & Competence; Global Citizenship}
- Must take the required number of hours from each category, to include additional number of hours (considered GE electives) from the GE form to meet 40 hours
- Nursing Majors will need to choose two (2) courses (6 hours) from the Cultural & Aesthetic Awareness section; (1) meeting the
   Intercultural Knowledge & Competence outcome and (1) meeting the Global Citizenship outcome.
- o Nursing Majors will need to choose and take (1) listed course to meet the OSHRE Computer Proficiency Requirement
- Nursing Majors will need to take (4) four hours from any of the listed Gen Ed course to meet the required Gen Ed requirements.
- Students MUST choose courses from the Gen Ed list to meet these requirements. Other courses have not been approved as a Gen Ed course at this time. Not all courses on the Gen Ed list will be offered EVERY semester, so advisors and students will need to verify which ones are available when the schedules go live.

Students who have completed an **Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree from an OKLAHOMA two-year college** will be considered as having met all general education requirements. This does not mean Required Related Work (RRW) specific courses in the major or minor requirements are met with the completion of the Associate Degree.

Students who have **completed a Bachelor's degree will be considered as having met all general education requirements.** This does not mean Required Related Work (RRW) specific courses in the major or minor requirements are met with the completion of the Bachelor's Degree.

Students pursuing a Second-Degree Bachelor's degree must complete **an additional 30 hours (151)** above the required number (121), to include the requirements for the new major.
