

Non-Resident Waiver Information

This full waiver of non-resident tuition is available to incoming freshmen, transfer students, international students, as well as continuing students.

To Qualify:

Beginning Freshmen and Transfer Students with less than 24 hours

- Cumulative 2.7 GPA on 4.0 scale and in the top 50% of the graduating class.
or
- Minimum composite 20 on the ACT or a 940 on the SAT in Math and Critical Reading.
or
- International Students must score a minimum of 64 on the Internet-Based (iBT), 180 Computer-Based (CBT), or 507-510 Paper-Based (PBT) on the TOEFL test; OR, a minimum overall Band Score of 6 on the IELTS.

Transfer Students

- Attempted at least 24 hours of transfer work (at any accredited institution) with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0.

Students **MUST** live in campus housing to utilize this waiver.

Students will be exempt from living in campus housing for the following reasons:

- 21 years of age or older
- Married
- Have children
- Extenuating Circumstances -- must submit reasons in writing to the Dean of Students.

To retain this scholarship:

Students will continue to receive this waiver as long as they maintain a 2.0 cumulative GPA, successfully complete 12 hours each semester, and live in campus housing.

Students do not need to reapply for this scholarship. Students will continue to receive the Non-Resident Tuition Waiver as long as they continue to meet the requirements.
