   (2) specific requirements in majors, minors or related work in these areas; or (3) the requirements for teacher certification.
- ⇒ A student must earn <u>at least 40 semester hours in upper-division</u> courses (numbered 3000 or higher). A course taught at EOSC may equate in content to an ECU 3000-4000 level course, but it will not be counted as part of the 40 hours of upper level courses.
