

McCullough named ECU's fulltime head coach



Kris McCullough's title at ECU no longer includes "interim." He carried the title since March, taking the Tigers to a 6-3 winning season so far, including the first 6-game winning streak since 1984. A huge feat while also being the youngest head coach in college football.

"Coach McCullough has earned the title of head football coach at ECU," President Wendell Godwin said. "He has been instrumental in building a culture of excellence on and off the field. When you consider what Coach McCullough has achieved in his college coaching career, it is quite impressive."


