- ⇒ A student must earn <u>at least 40 semester hours in upper-division</u> courses (numbered 3000 or higher). A course taught at OCCC may equate in content to an ECU 3000-4000 level course, but it will not be counted as part of the 40 hours of upper level courses.
- ⇒ A student must earn <u>at least 60 semester hours</u>, excluding physical activity courses, at a baccalaureate degree granting institution.
- \Rightarrow A Student must earn <u>at least 124 credit hours</u> that apply to an ECU Bachelor's degree.
