INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING THE CERTIFICATE OF EXEMPTION

Oklahoma law requires that all students attending college in this state submit acceptable evidence of adequate immunization. Such evidence is required before the student is allowed to enter or attend. Students with specific medical contraindications to any or all immunizations may be allowed to attend if the medical reason is stated and this statement is signed by a licensed physician and submitted to the institution. Students who have objections to immunizations based on religious teachings or personal beliefs can also apply for an exemption.

Copies of immunization records and any Certificate of Exemption must be on file with the institution and available for review.

LOST IMMUNIZATION RECORDS

Lost immunizations records are not grounds for an exemption to Oklahoma Law. Students who have lost records should be referred to their local health department or family physician. The nurse or doctor can interpret the past immunization history and provide any needed immunizations and create a record that can be submitted to the college and transcribed for the student's record.

EXCLUSION DURING A DISEASE OUTBREAK

A disease outbreak in East Central University will very likely result in exposure of students attending on the basis of an exemption. These students are very likely to be susceptible to the diseases and therefore may have to be excluded for the duration of any outbreak for their own health and for the health of the other students. Students should be informed of this possibility before signing a Certificate of Exemption.
