Oklahoma Subject Area Test (OSAT)

The Oklahoma Department of Education (OSDE) and Oklahoma Educational Quality and Accountability (OEQA) require educators to pass the Oklahoma Subject Area Test (OSAT) to receive teacher certification. The EPP highly encourages students to take the OSAT prior to the student teaching semester. Advanced level students must pass the OSAT for certification.

Praxis Performance Assessment for Teachers (PPAT)

The EPP began requiring the PPAT as a pilot for the state in the Fall of 2017. The PPAT is a performance-based assessment that all undergraduate student teachers complete and submit nationally.
