Murphy Bondurant Scholarship

The Murphy Bondurant Scholarship was established by alumna Sara Murphy Bondurant and her husband Michael to bring greater awareness to the need for mental health services and drug abuse prevention. This scholarship is awarded to ECU students attending full-time and based on a 1-3 page essay regarding: "How their education will impact mental health awareness and drug abuse prevention".

The 2021 recipient is ECU junior Colton Schaper-Kotter. He graduated in 2018 at Vernon Secondary School based out of Vernon British Columbia, Canada, his hometown. He is majoring in Business Management with the goal of also obtaining a certificate in Human Resource Management. "After obtaining my bachelors, my plan is to pursue my masters in management here at ECU," he said. "After my time at ECU, I plan on attending Law School. After my schooling is complete, I will work hard to join a law firm where my career can excel."

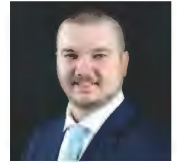

Distinguished Alumnus

Devon Energy Senior Vice President and Chief Accounting Officer Jeremy Humphers has been named East Central University's Distinguished Alumnus for 2021.


"It's definitely humbling and it's an honor," Humphers said. "It's hard to take individual credit for it. I have been surrounded by a lot of people who have helped me be successful, and anytime some kind of acknowledgment like this comes my way it's easy for me to see a lot of people who helped me get there."

Humphers graduated with honors from ECU in 1996, earning his degree in Accounting. Born in rural Pontotoc County, his first exposure to accounting came at Byng High School.

"Outside the office, Humphers spends time volunteering his talents. He has served the Regional Food Bank of Oklahoma, the Norman Youth Soccer Association, and the ECU Foundation. He is also a deacon and treasurer of the Norman Church of Christ. Throughout all his success, he credits ECU for helping pave the way.

Above all, Humphers is a family man.


That quickly becomes evident in any conversation with him. He and his wife Becky have been married for 26 years and have two healthy, happy children – his son Jacob, 21, and his daughter Kenady, 18. "I learned the value of hard work from my dad and the value of giving to others to improve our communities from

 my mom," Humphers said. "They wanted their children to achieve all



they can and even more than them. When I look at my children, one of the goals I have with them is for them to be more successful and dream bigger than I might have even imagined for myself."

Humphers gives the majority of credit to his wife Becky. "Christmas Eve, our sophomore year at ECU, we went on a date and the rest is history," he said. "She's wonderful, a cancer survivor, a great mother, very caring of others. Our kids do well because of the care and guidance

she gives them. I wouldn't be where I am today without her."

Distinguished *Service Award*

Highlighting a decade of service on the East Central University Foundation's Board of Directors, as well as its Investment Committee, Yancy Spivey has been named the 2021 recipient of ECU's Distinguished Service Award.

In the past year, Spivey worked with an anonymous donor to secure a \$6.5 million gift that will be earmarked toward ECU's Nursing program. Although the generous donation will be spread across the next 20 years, its impact will last into perpetuity.


"I certainly cannot take credit for this gift," said Spivey, who runs his own investment firm in Duncan, Oklahoma. "When you have such a willing family who loves ECU and wants to help, it really is pretty easy to facilitate a win-win platform. The University's work in this field has been recognized as a game changer in our region, and hopefully this gift will positively influence future generations to come to ECU."

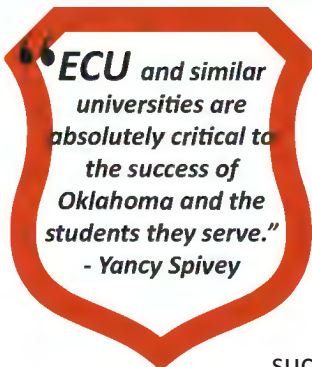
Spivey's relationship with ECU began in 2007, when he arrived in Ada as president of Arvest Bank. His wife Laura, who was a teacher in the Ada City Schools system for several years, and their four children lived in the community until his career took them to Duncan. Thankfully, that was more than enough time for Spivey to become closely involved with the ECU Foundation and the Tiger family.



Whether it's helping secure a financial gift for the Foundation or working directly with faculty and students on a project, Spivey has proven himself to be a valuable resource for ECU – even when he lives in a community 90 miles west of Ada.

"I continue to be involved in events when I can, and I still enjoy my time on the Foundation board, but having that access on a daily basis was a privilege," he said. "It's a tremendous blessing for me just to play a small part in the continued

success of ECU."

GIFTS OF CASH

These gifts are always welcome because they are available immediately to strengthen the University or begin earning income for the future.

GIFTS OF SECURITIES

These gifts include stocks, bonds, mutual funds, and IRAs, and also are available immediately to impact the work of the Foundation.

GIFTS OF PERSONAL PROPERTY

Personal property can include coin collections, antique cars, gun collections, artwork, etc.

GIFTS OF REAL PROPERTY

Real estate, homes, business property and farmland that has grown in value can result in tax advantages through a charitable gift to the Foundation.

GIFTS OF TRUSTS

This can include charitable remainder trusts, unitrusts, lead trusts, family trusts, annuity trusts, etc., which can avoid capital gains taxes and provide an annual income for life.

GIFTS OF BEQUESTS

At a donor's death, gifts directed by a will or a living trust are deducted from the most highly taxed portion of the donor's estate, resulting in less taxes and a larger distribution of the estate to the heirs. This is perhaps the most basic and flexible of estate planning instruments.

GIFTS OF INSURANCE

By assigning ownership to the Foundation or making the Foundation the beneficiary of a life insurance policy that is no longer needed for its original purpose (such as sheltering children's education), a donor can make a substantial gift at a low cost and take an immediate income tax deduction for the value of the policy.

A donor then can contribute an amount equal to the policy's premiums to the Foundation and deduct that gift as a charitable contribution. Proceeds of the policy will pass to the Foundation free of estate taxes.

ECU student Kelley Gutierrez received several scholarships during her time at East Central University, including the Lowell E. Green Scholarship, Virgil Taylor Scholarship, Quiet-Gerlach Counseling Scholarship, DCT CLASS Graduate Centennial Endowment Scholarship, and the Clayton A. Morgan Rehabilitation Leadership Award.

“Having those scholarships made it to where I won’t need to take out as many loans as I have in the past, so I’ll owe less in the future,” she said. “I try to honor the named individual as well as the family by putting forth my best effort. I have been honored to receive a scholarship in their name. I want to honor them by making it a worthwhile investment into my future.”

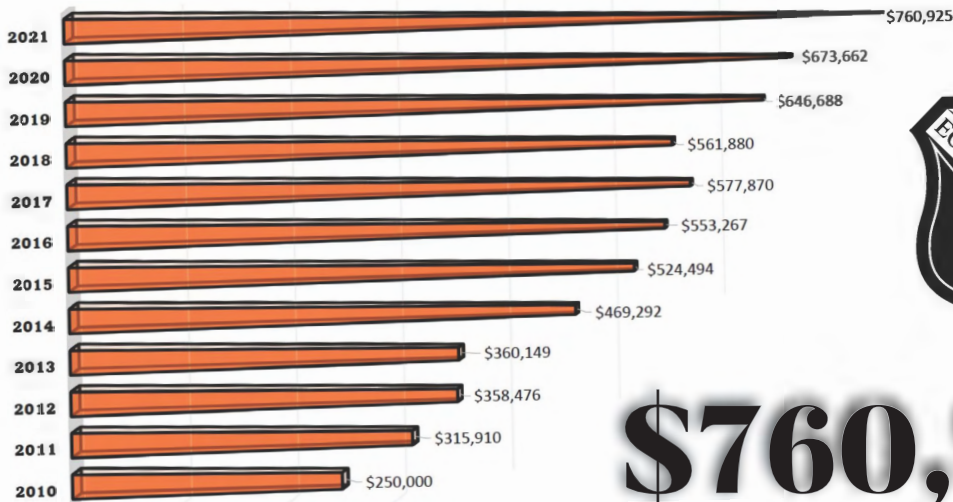

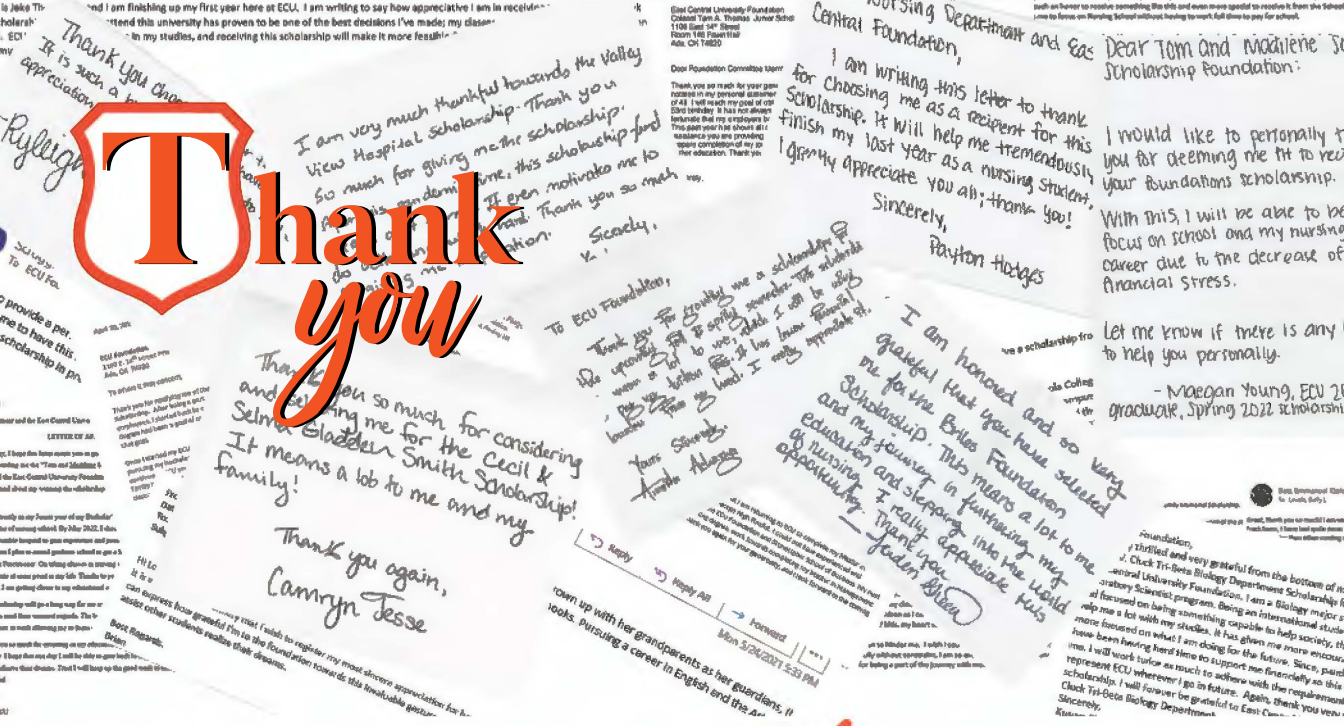
