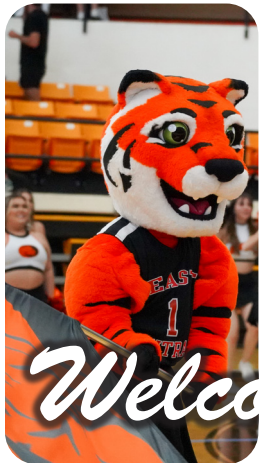

Homecoming Parade is scheduled for 12:30 p.m.

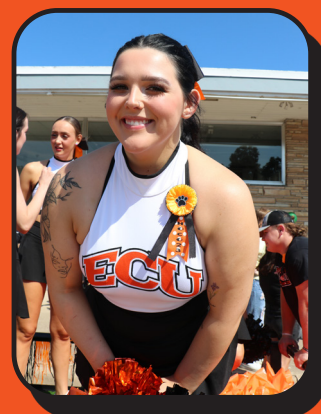
