
East Central University (ECU) in Ada, Oklahoma is excited to offer **Mapping Water Stories**, a five-day 24-hour supervised residential summer academy for 35 Oklahoma students (grades 8-12), June 5-June 9, 2023. This summer academy provides hands-on learning opportunities about water from scientific, environmental, and other cultural perspectives. Students will visit local lakes and streams to collect water data and learn how to create a Geographic Information System (GIS) map in the ECU GIS computer lab. All meals will be provided. organizations throughout the week to
assist with our lessons and experiments.





## **Daily Schedule:**

Monday, June 5: Getting Started! Our partner to learn about Water Testing is Blue Thumb, a program of the Oklahoma Conservation Commission



Tuesday, June 6: Water in Art and Stories: Use water to make art with recycled glass and experience Chickasaw stories about water







Wednesday, June 7: Chickasaw Water Day. We go by bus to Sulphur to visit the Chickasaw Nation Cultural Center and the Chickasaw National Recreation Area. We will do a Bug Walk in the creek and practice our water testing skills. Bring your swimming suit and water shoes!



Thursday, June 8: EPA Day: We will go by bus to visit the US Environmental Protection Agency lab in Ada as well as Byrds Mill Spring, the source of Ada's water. We will also start using GIS to make our maps in an ECU computer lab.





Friday, June 9: Oka Institute Day and Wrap Up. Scientists from ECU Oka Institute will lead a lesson on groundwater. We will finish our maps and hold our Award Ceremony!
