BS with a Major in Nursing

The School of Nursing offers the Bachelor of Science with a major in nursing degree to prelicensure students at two campus sites in Ada and Durant. Pre-licensure students complete a 5-semester nursing program leading to the degree of Bachelors of Science in nursing. Graduates who meet the Oklahoma state requirements for licensure, including a clear criminal background

check, are eligible to apply to write the National Council Licensing Examination for Registered Nurses (NCLEX-RN) to become a Registered Nurse."
