10	An Act relating to higher education; transferring governance, supervision, management and control of
11	the Ardmore Higher Education Program from the Board of Trustees for the Ardmore Higher Education Program
12	to the Regional University System of Oklahoma; transferring all interests and obligations of the
13	Board of Trustees and the Ardmore Higher Education Program; requiring assumption of obligations for
14	tenure and retirement by the Regional University System of Oklahoma; requiring certain facilities to
15	serve as branch campus in Ardmore of Southeastern Oklahoma State University; authorizing Regional
16	University System of Oklahoma to provide resources to branch campus for certain purpose; requiring Oklahoma
17	State Regents for Higher Education to make college
18	credit courses and programs available to people of Ardmore and Southern Oklahoma; requiring
19	establishment of branch campus of Southeastern Oklahoma State University at Ardmore; providing for
20	governance of Ardmore branch campus by Regional University System of Oklahoma; providing for lower
21	division courses and programs to be offered by Murray State College with right to defer to Southeastern
22	Oklahoma State University; establishing certain advisory board; providing for membership; stating
23	duties; prohibiting duplication of certain courses and programs; providing for East Central University
24	to offer additional programs; providing for the phasing in of provisions of this act; repealing 70

O.S. 2001, Section 3213, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 73, O.S.L. 2009 (70 O.S. Supp. 2010, Section 3213), which relates to the Ardmore Higher Education Program; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3515.1 of Title 70, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

10 Α. The governance, supervision, management and control of the Ardmore Higher Education Program is hereby transferred from the 11 12 Board of Trustees for the Ardmore Higher Education Program to the 13 Regional University System of Oklahoma, and all interests in real property, facilities, equipment and appurtenances, state-14 appropriated monies and all duties, obligations and liabilities of 15 the Ardmore Higher Education Program and any and all obligations of 16 the Board of Trustees of the Ardmore Higher Education Program for 17 and on behalf of the Ardmore Higher Education Program are 18 transferred to the Regional University System of Oklahoma. 19 Obligations for any and all plans for tenure or retirement of 20 employees of the Ardmore Higher Education Program, either through 21 the Ardmore Higher Education Program or the Board of Trustees for 2.2 the Ardmore Higher Education Program, shall be assumed by the 23 Regional University System of Oklahoma. 24

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B. The facilities of the Ardmore Higher Education Program shall
 serve as the branch campus in Ardmore of Southeastern Oklahoma State
 University. The Regional University System of Oklahoma may provide
 resources to the branch campus in Ardmore of Southeastern Oklahoma
 State University to maintain its facilities in accordance with its
 function and mission as provided by law.

7 C. The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education shall make undergraduate and graduate college credit courses and programs 8 9 available to the people of Ardmore and Southern Oklahoma. The 10 Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education shall provide courses 11 and programs through a branch campus of Southeastern Oklahoma State 12 University, which shall be established and located in Ardmore. The 13 branch campus of Southeastern Oklahoma State University at Ardmore shall be governed by the Regional University System of Oklahoma and 14 15 administered through Southeastern Oklahoma State University.

D. Murray State College shall offer and have the right to defer to Southeastern Oklahoma State University for the offering of all lower division courses and programs at the branch campus of Southeastern Oklahoma State University at Ardmore. Lower division courses and programs offered at the undergraduate level at the branch campus of Southeastern Oklahoma State University at Ardmore shall not duplicate those offered by Murray State College.

E. The members serving on the Board of Trustees for the ArdmoreHigher Education Program established pursuant to Section 3213 of

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1 Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes on the effective date of this act 2 shall serve as an advisory board to the president of Southeastern Oklahoma State University. The advisory board shall advise the 3 president of Southeastern Oklahoma State University on strategic 4 5 directions for the branch campus of Southeastern Oklahoma State University at Ardmore, including academic programming, student 6 services, community relations, and institutional advancement. 7 The advisory board, in coordination with the president of Southeastern 8 9 Oklahoma State University, shall establish bylaws and membership of 10 the advisory board.

F. Courses offered at Southeastern Oklahoma State University at
Ardmore shall not duplicate nursing program courses offered at East
Central University campus at Ardmore.

G. The consolidation of Ardmore Higher Education Center and 14 15 Southeastern Oklahoma State University shall protect the continuing and historic relationships which exist between Ardmore Higher 16 Education Center, Murray State College, and East Central University. 17 Each institution shall be allowed to continue its historic course 18 and program offerings. Southeastern Oklahoma State University shall 19 assume management of Ardmore Higher Education Center and shall be 20 one of three educational providers at the Center. East Central 21 University may offer additional courses which Southeastern Oklahoma 22 State University and East Central University mutually agree are in 23 the best interest of the community. 24

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1	H. Southeastern Oklahoma State University shall assume all the
2	duties and powers provided for in this act by July 1, 2014.
3	SECTION 2. REPEALER 70 O.S. 2001, Section 3213, as
4	amended by Section 1, Chapter 73, O.S.L. 2009 (70 O.S. Supp. 2010,
5	Section 3213) is hereby repealed.
6	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.
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
