- Pay for malpractice insurance – payable to ECU School of Nursing (details in Acceptance Packet)

- Tuberculin Skin Test (PPD)
- Immunization records (or titers reflecting immunity) with: MMR; Hepatitis B; Varicella zoster; Tdap; influenza; meningococcal – see ECU nursing website and/or instructions in CastleBranch for more details
- CPR: Basic Life Support for Healthcare Providers from American Heart Association or American Red Cross
- 10-panel urine drug screen
- Federal criminal background and sex offenders search*
- Official transcript for the fall semester from institutions other than ECU by the **first day of classes in January, close of business**

*Criminal background, violent offender, and sex offender registry searches are required as part of the acceptance packet. Felony convictions are an absolute bar to licensing for five years. If you have a criminal record, and/or have been arrested and/or summoned to appear in court, you are required to notify the ECU School of Nursing Director in writing PRIOR to submitting your application.
