**VII. Special Requirements**

Students should obtain a detailed guide to the program from their advisor. An unrestricted Oklahoma RN license and a GPA of 2.5/4.0 required for admission. A grade of "C" or better in each nursing course is required for graduation. Students who earn a "D" or an "F" in a nursing course must repeat that course with a grade of "C" or higher before continuing in the nursing program.

Malpractice insurance is required for all students enrolled in any nursing course which has a clinical or laboratory component. Malpractice insurance may be obtained through the University at specified times.

The OSRHE computer proficiency graduation requirement will be met through completion of CMPSC 1513 (including equated or substituted courses), or testing out of the challenge exam for this course, **OR** successful completion of an associate of arts or associate of science degree at an Oklahoma two-year college in which the computer skills requirement was met. Satisfaction of this requirement may not reduce or remove any program requirements.
