I. PROGRAM CORE (15 hours)

IV. PORTFOLIO OR THESIS (3 hours)

Students should choose EITHER the Portfolio or Thesis option. If the Portfolio option is selected, EDUC 5342 Supervised Portfolio Research should be taken the semester immediately following EDUC 5113 Techniques of Research, and EDUC 5681 Portfolio should be taken in the final semester.

Portfolio option:

V. SPECIALIZATION OR ELECTIVES

Specialization is further work in any teaching area in which a student has completed a minimum of 12 semester hours. Specialization in music will include a maximum of 10 hours of upper division or 5000-level courses and unspecified electives with the advisor's approval to complete a program of 32 semester hours.
