

## Master in Management (MiM) Program of Study Options for International Students

Due to F1 student visa requirements, international students are limited to the following options for progression through the MiM program. All international students must select one of the following options and any deviation will result in delayed graduation and/or failure to meet F1 visa requirements. It is the student's responsibility to adhere to one of the following options.

Option #1: Student starts the program during a fall term and takes 9 credit hours a semester.

Fall – FIN5103, MGMT5103 (online), MGMT5203

Spring - ACCT5113 (online), MGMT5503, MGMT5703

Summer – BUSLW5203 (online)

Fall-ECON5103 (online), MGMT5043, MKTG5103

Option #2: Student starts the program during a fall term and completes the program in 1 year. Fall – ECON5103 (online), FIN5103, MGMT5103 (online), MGMT5203, MKTG5103 Spring – ACCT5113 (online), MGMT5043, MGMT5503, MGMT5703 Summer – BUSLW5203 (online)

## Notes:

- 1. *International students must enroll in all listed courses before the first week of classes.* If you do not enroll the week before classes start, a required (on-campus) course may be dropped from the schedule, and you will not be able to meet visa residency requirements.
- 2. International students must select one of the plans listed above and are not allowed to deviate from their chosen plan. Any deviation may result in loss of residency status.
- 3. Option #1 is the preferred option for all international students.
- 4. Option #2 requires special permission to enroll in 15 graduate hours the first semester.
- 5. Both options require enrollment in an additional face-to-face class (outside of major) during the summer semester if the student wishes to remain in the U.S. for the summer.
- 6. Failure to earn a C or better in a class may result in loss of residency status and F1 visa.
- 7. MGMT5203 is a prerequisite for MGMT5503
- 8. MGMT5103 and FIN5103 are prerequisites for MGMT5703
