

Master in Management (MiM) Program of Study Options for Non-international Students

All non-international MiM students must select one of the following options and any deviation may result in delayed graduation and/or inability to maintain full time status (if applicable). It is the student's responsibility to adhere to one of the following options.

Option #1: Student starts the program during a fall term and takes 6 credit hours a semester.

Fall – MGMT5103 (online), MGMT5203

Spring – ACCT5113 (online) MGMT5043

Summer – BUSLW5203 (online)

Fall – FIN5103, MKTG5103

Spring – MGMT5503, MGMT5703

Fall – ECON5103 (online)

Option #2: Student starts the program during a fall term and takes 9 credit hours a semester.

Fall – FIN5103, MGMT5103 (online), MGMT5203

Spring – ACCT5113 (online), MGMT5503, MGMT5703

Summer – BUSLW5203 (online)

Fall – ECON5103 (online), MGMT5043, MKTG5103

Option #3: Student starts the program during a fall term and 12+ credit hours a semester.

Fall – ECON5103 (online), FIN5103, MGMT5103 (online), MGMT5203, MKTG5103 Spring – ACCT5113 (online), MGMT5043, MGMT5503, MGMT5703

Summer – BUSLW5203 (online)

Notes:

- 1. Option #1 requires 2 ½ years to complete.
- 2. Option #2 requires 1 ½ years to complete.
- 3. Option #3 requires 1 year to complete and special permission to enroll in 15 hours.
- 4. Failure to earn a C or better in a class may result in delayed graduation.
- 5. Failure to *enroll before all classes start* may result in a course being dropped from the schedule, thus it is imperative that students *enroll prior to the start of the semester*.
- 6. MGMT5203 is a prerequisite for MGMT5503
- 7. MGMT5103 and FIN5103 are prerequisites for MGMT5703
