

The Ozella Elizabeth Waner Scholarship
for **English** Majors
at East Central University

Terms of Scholarship:

The Ozella Elizabeth Waner Scholarship will provide one first-year student majoring in English all funding for tuition, fees, and books. It also provides for room and board if the student lives in university housing. Students who continue as English majors and maintain at least an overall 3.25 GPA and who complete at least 24 credit hours per year will be re-awarded the scholarship for a maximum of eight consecutive, regular semesters. Summer school is not included.

Eligibility:

Those entering their first semester of full time college enrollment who have completed no more than twelve semester hours (not counting advanced standing).

Those who declare English as an academic major and express a commitment to enrollment in courses leading to a degree in English, and who maintain that commitment.

Those having an ACT score of 25 or higher.

Preference will be given to students ineligible for Federal Financial Aid who can show evidence of economic need.

Application and Selection Process:

Complete the Ozella Elizabeth Waner Scholarship Application Form. Attach official copies of high school transcript (or equivalency of high school diploma), two letters of recommendation and your ACT scores, (one letter of recommendation should be from a high school junior or senior English teacher). An essay as specified on the application form should also be included. An interview with the ECU Ozella Elizabeth Waner Scholarship Committee is a part of the selection process.

Continuation Terms and Details:

The Ozella Elizabeth Waner Scholarship will be re-awarded for a maximum of four years (eight consecutive, regular college semesters) if students maintain at least an overall 3.25 GPA, complete at least 24 credit hours per academic year in courses leading to an efficient completion of the English degree, and remain in good standing with the university.

Any additional financial aid (federal or state aid, fee waivers, scholarships, grants, etc.) will reduce the Ozella Elizabeth Waner Scholarship by the same amount.

Room and board funds are contingent on living in university housing.

No books provided by scholarship monies may be sold for cash. Students may keep all texts in their major academic area. Other texts must be returned to the ECU Foundation.
