INSTRUCTIONS

The State Regents cannot enroll a student in Oklahoma's Promise unless the income documents are included with the signature page. Any falsified or undisclosed financial information will result in the student's disqualification from the program.

Section I: Parents required to file a federal income tax return must complete this section:

The federal adjusted gross income (AGI) of the student's parent(s) for the most recently completed federal tax year must not exceed \$55,000. Parents must send a copy of pages 1 and 2 of the federal income tax (1040/1040A) return. IRS forms submitted to the State Regents are kept confidential and used only to verify Oklahoma's Promise eligibility.

Special income provisions may apply to children adopted from certain court-ordered custody, children in the custody of court-appointed legal guardians and families receiving Social Security benefits based on the disability or death of the student's parents. Documentation of the court authorization is required for adoption and legal guardianship. Verification of social security benefits is also required.
