#### HOW TO APPLY FOR ON CAMPUS HOUSING

- Using your preferred web browser go to <a href="https://www.ecok.edu/housing">www.ecok.edu/housing</a>.
- Under the Housing and
  Residence Life column select
  Apply for Housing from the list of options.
- Read the information provided then select the Housing Application Site link.
- Log in to the ECU housing application using your ECU student username and password.
- Follow the steps on each page.
  Be sure to save your progress after each step.

- Pay the \$75 nonrefundable application fee online or in person at the Bursar's Office,
  Administration Building, Rm 108.
  If paid in person, receipt must be taken to the Housing and Residence Life Office.
- Complete the lifestyle profile section, fill out your room preferences and search for a potential roommate. The application will automatically stop your progress after this step.
- Wait for an e-mail from Housing with a date and time to return to the application to select a room.
- Log in to select a room, meal plan and sign the Housing contract.
  Your application is now complete.

You will need your ECU email, username and password to complete the application. After being admitted, all of these items can be accessed by going to <a href="https://www.ecok.edu/passreset/passreset.html">https://www.ecok.edu/passreset/passreset.html</a> and providing your social security number and birth date. Once you have your login information you will need to complete the application steps. All correspondence from the Housing and Residence Life Office will be sent to your ECU student email address.

## FRESHMAN RESIDENCE REQUIREMENT

East Central University is committed to student success. Integral to student success and a student-centered experience is involvement in student life. One of the best ways to become involved in student life is for students to reside in the residence halls. Research has shown that students who live on campus persist and graduate at higher rates, are more satisfied with their personal college experience, and show more development than students who do not live on campus. In light of the benefits of on-campus living, all freshmen students under the age of 21 shall live on campus for their first academic year. Summer sessions are excluded.

#### Exemptions to this policy include:

- If the student resides with their parent(s) or legal guardian(s) within a 35-mile radius of Ada, Oklahoma
- If the student is 21 years of age or older on or before the first day of classes of their first semester of ECU.
- If the student is married.
- If the student has dependents who live with them.
- If the student has 24+ hours earned post high school.
- If the student transfers from another college or university with 24+ hours earned post high school.
- If the student enrolls in less than 12 credit hours per semester.
- Other extreme circumstances to be reviewed by the Office of Housing and Residence Life and/or Office of Student Development.

Students who fall within one of the above exemptions must complete a Freshman Residence Requirement Exemption Request form and provide all supporting documentation to the Office of Housing and Residence Life. Students filing a request based on living with a parent or legal guardian must reside with that parent or legal guardian on a daily basis, at their primary residence, within a 35-mile radius of Ada, Oklahoma for the entire academic year. The parent(s)/legal guardian(s) must have established their primary residency at least six months prior to the request for an exemption. If the student moves out of that residence, he/she and the parent/legal guardian must notify the Department of Housing and Residence Life and move into the residence halls within 5 business days.

Students who are found in violation of the residency requirement will be subject to a fee assessment of \$500.00 and must move into the residence halls within 48 hours. This policy may be modified by the President.

#### **DINING OPTIONS**

East Central University offers various meal plans for students living on and off campus. All students living on campus are required to purchase a meal plan. The weekly meal plans may be used in Taff Cafeteria or by using a meal transfer in the University Center Snack Bar. Individuals living off campus that would like to

purchase a meal plan may do so by completing the <u>Off-Campus Meal Plan Agreement</u> and submitting it to the Housing and Residence Life office within the first ten days of class each semester.

#### Taff Cafeteria:

Serves breakfast, lunch and dinner Monday through Saturday and only breakfast and lunch on Sundays. Taff Cafeteria provides numberous dining options including a sauteed pasta bar, home-style bar, salad bar, sandwich bar, pizza oven, dessert bar and soft served ice cream. The meals are buffet style.

#### **University Center Snack Bar:**

Serves breakfast, lunch and dinner Monday through Friday. The Snack Bar includes Starbucks coffee station, sub-sandwiches and a grill station.
