

East Central University Student Senate Campaign Rules



Campaign Materials

Campaign material may be distributed on campus only after the candidate has completed filing. Campaign materials **may not** be placed on glass doors or painted walls/surfaces.

Posters

Size: 22" X 14" (one-half the size of a standard poster board)

All posters **must be signed on the back** by the candidate.

A list of all poster locations must be turned into the Student Activities Office within 24 hours of placement. An updated list of any changes must be submitted to the Student Activities Office within 24 hours of such changes.

Each candidate has a **15** poster limit.

No more than **TWO** posters may be placed in any of the following buildings:

Administration	Science Hall	Memorial Student Union
Horace Mann	Faust Hall	Pesagi Hall
Pontotoc Hall	Briles Hall	
Physical and Environmental Science Center		

*****OTHER BUILDINGS ARE OFF LIMITS*****

Posters must be removed by 5 P.M. following the day of the election.

Handouts

The candidate or a designated worker may pass out literature, fliers, pamphlets, or other campaign materials on campus to students who freely accept it.

- Materials may not be left in piles or stacks.
- Material(s) may not be displayed other than in above mentioned posters.
- Material(s) may not be placed on cars.
- Material(s) may not be slid under any doors including the residence halls.

Other Campaign Materials

- Limited to the following:
 - ✓ Advertisements may be placed on Radio, TV, and/or in the Newspaper.
 - ✓ Supporters of the candidate may wear buttons, stickers or printed T-Shirts.

Election

All candidates are encouraged to furnish a 5 X 7 photo to be placed on the wall at the election site. The photo must be brought to the Student Activities Office **48 hours prior** to the opening of the polls. The pictures must be picked up within one week following the election, or they will be discarded. On the day of the election, there shall be **NO** personal or organized campaigning of any kind **within 25 feet** of the stated election site.

Violation of Election Rules

- Campaign materials found in un-designated places may be removed by any Student Senator or Hour Court Justice and delivered to the Student Activities Office.
- On a candidate's first violation of any of the above rules, the candidate will have 24 hours to correct violation.
- Failure to correct the violation within the 24 hour time period will result in the removal of the candidate from the race.
- East Central University Honor Court will review all violations.
