## **East Central University Student Senate Eligibility**



- 1. To be eligible for any office, including Class Representative, a student must have at the time of filing, and must maintain a grade point average of 2.5 per semester on a 4.0 scale at East Central University. Freshman Representatives shall be exempted from this rule.
  - a. Freshman Representative must have been admitted to the University on good standing and must maintain a **2.5 throughout the term of office**.
  - b. Any senator not upholding his or her GPA requirement shall be expelled.
- 2. **Class Representatives** must meet the class qualifications by the beginning of the first full semester of their tenure in office.
- 3. At Large Representatives shall be defined in the following way:
  - a. **Minority Student Representative-**other than Caucasian as reported during the time of enrollment.
  - b. **Commuter Student Representative**-a person [who is] enrolled as a full time student and 'can' certify that he or she plans to attend East Central University for the full term of office of which he or she seeks...with a current address that is off campus; the candidate may not be a resident of campus housing.
  - c. Non-Traditional Student Representative-a student with a five (5) or more year's absence in formal education after high school or previous formal education enrollment.
  - d. **Campus Housing Student Representative**-a student who resides in an East Central University residence hall, Knight Hall, Tiger Commons, or Married Student Housing.
  - e. **Varsity Athlete Student Representative**-any student with an earned varsity athletic letter in any sport formally recognized by East Central University
  - f. **Graduate Student Representative**-any student with at least a 3.0 grade point average, enrolled in a minimum of nine (9) hours, and admitted into an East Central University graduate program
  - g. **Student with Disabilities Representative**-student registered as having a disability with Student Support Services
  - h. **Veterans Student Representative**-any student that is a military veteran and classified as such through ECU Office of Admissions and Records.
