ANATOMY (BIOL 2184) Prerequisites: Biology (BIOL 1114)

MICROBIOLOGY (BIOL 2344) Prerequisites: Biology (BIOL 1114) & Chemistry (CHEM 1114 OR CHEM 1324)

PHYSIOLOGY (BIOL 3634) Prerequisites: Anatomy (BIOL 2184) OR Microbiology (BIOL 2344) & Chemistry (CHEM 1114 OR CHEM 1324)

CHEMISTRY Prerequisite/Corequisite: College Algebra (MATH 1513) OR Functions & Modeling (MATH 1613)

Students who have completed an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree from an OKLAHOMA two-year college will be considered as having met all general education requirements listed above. This does not mean Required Related Work (RRW) specific courses in the major or minor requirements are met with the completion of the Associate Degree.

NOTE: If student puts in a waiver for UNIV 1001, they will NOT get the one-hour credit awarded on their transcript. With taking nutrition (3 hours), they should still have 44 hours of Gen Eds and meet the requirements. Please double check that there are no other variations in their Gen Ed courses if transferred in so the student is not short hours.
