 - You MUST take the HESI A2 offered through ECU SoN. We will not accept HESI A2 entrance exam results from another university or school.
 - You MUST take all the required sections of the exam, to include the Learner Profile and the Critical Thinking
 - Your results will be automatically sent to the ECU School of Nursing upon completion of your exam.
 - The HESI A2 is offered remotely, multiple times a day.
 - The cost of the exam is \$70.00 per attempt. You are allowed two attempts and the results are good for 12-months from the date of exam
 - Minimum composite score of 75% is required
- Official** transcript(s) from EACH university or college you have attended are required:
 - Official transcripts may be included with your application packet as long as they remain sealed
 - If you are having transcripts mailed, please have them sent to **ECU School of Nursing, 1100 E 14th Street, PMB V-8, Ada, OK 74820**
 - If your transcripts are to be delivered electronically, please have them sent to nurse_sec@ecok.edu
 - If you have sent official transcripts to ECU Admissions prior to submitting your nursing application, please note that on the verification form. We will be happy to work with Admissions to get a copy from them. Also, we will send a copy of your official over to Admissions if we receive them, so you do not have to send an additional copy.
 - Transcripts MUST be received, regardless of method, no later than 5pm on September 5, 2022.
